

## Construction Update For 28 Chestnut Street

Scheduled Activities for Week of 11.28.21 – 12.4.21

The following is a list of activities expected to take place:

## **Soil Management:**

- Offsite trucking of excess soil. Soils will be loaded from the south end slurry walls remaining in the south end of the building's footprint.
- Trucks will enter and exit the site via the south gate, leaving the Brickbottom neighborhood traveling north onto Chestnut Street.
- Trucking frequency to be approximately 25 trailers per day.

## **Slurry Guide Wall Installation:**

- Daily activities to include excavation, rebar tying, rebar installation, and concrete casting.
- Activities will include daily use of the south gate for deliveries, utilizing cranes, excavators, and front-end loader equipment.
- Slurry wall construction work is COMPLETING in the south and south-central portions of the new buildings' footprint and will transition to the north and north central.
- Activities may also include longer work days, up to or slightly after 7PM. If the work exceeds the 7PM City Ordinance due to a longer concrete pour, Consigli will seek prior City approval. All efforts will be made to avoid extending hours when possible.

## Saturday, 12/4, will be a workday:

- Reset of the slurry pipeline from the south end of the site to the central area.
- Resetting of the slurry pipeline allows for detailed excavation and cap beam installation to begin in December at the south end of the site.
